## Materials:

Worsted Weight Yarn in Yellow, Orange and White (unless you like the Brown/Orange/White candies better)

Double Pointed or Circular Needles in Size US 7 (7, 8)

Tapestry Needle

## Gauge:

For **Small** and **Medium** on US 7 needles, 10.5 stitches and 14 rows to 2". For **Large** on US 8 needles, 10 stitches and 13 rows to 2". If you are getting more stitches in 2", your hat will be smaller than mine. If you are getting less stitches in 2", your hat will be larger than mine.

## Abbreviations

K2tog = Knit two stitches together as if they were one stitch.

# Candy Corn Hat



## Pattern:

Cast on 60 (72, 80) stitches in Yellow. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist your stitches.

**Rounds 1-10:** Working in Yellow \*K1, P1\* repeat to end of row.

**Rounds 11-20:** Knit all stitches.

**Note:** For Small hat, change to Orange yarn.

**Rounds 21-22:** Knit all stitches.

**Note:** For Medium and Large hats, change to Orange yarn.

**Rounds 23-25:** Knit all stitches.

**Round 26:** \*Knit 8 (10, 8), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 54 (66, 72)

**Rounds 27-28:** (27-29, 27-29): Knit all stitches.

**Rounds 29 (30, 30):** \*Knit 7 (9, 7), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining stitches:** 48 (60, 64)

**Rounds 30-31 (31-33, 31-33):** Knit all stitches.

**Round 32 (34, 34):** \*Knit 6 (8, 6), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 42 (54, 56)

**Rounds 33-34 (35-37, 35-37):** Knit all stitches.

**Round 35 (38, 38):** \*Knit 5 (7, 5), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 36 (48, 48)

**Rounds 36 (39, 39):** Knit all Stitches.

**Note:** For Small hat, change to White yarn.

**Rounds 37 (40-41, 40-41):** Knit all Stitches.

**Round 38 (42, 42,):** \*Knit 4 (6, 4), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 30 (42, 40)

**Round 39 (43, 43):** Knit all stitches.

**Note:** For Medium and Large hats, change to White yarn.

**Round 40 (44-45, 44-45):** Knit all stitches.

**Round 41 (46, 46):** \*Knit 3 (5, 3), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 24 (36, 32)

**Rounds 42-43 (47-49, 47-49):** Knit all stitches.

**Round 44 (50, 50):** \*Knit 2 (4, 2), K2tog\* Repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 18 (30, 24)

**Rounds 45-46 (51-53, 51-53):** Knit all stitches.

**Round 47 (54, 54):** \*Knit 1 (3, 1), K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining Stitches:** 12 (24, 16)

**Rounds 48-49 (55-57, 55-57):** Knit all stitches.

**Round 50 (58, 58):** \*K2tog\* (\*K2, K2tog\*, \*K2tog\*) repeat to end of row.

**Remaining stitches:** 6 (18, 8)

**\*\* Rounds 59-66 For Medium Only!\*\*\***

**Rounds 59-61:** Knit all stitches.

**Round 62:** \*K1, K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining stitches:** 12

**Rounds 63-65:** Knit all stitches.

**Round 66:** \*K2tog\* repeat to end of row.

**Remaining stitches:** 6

## Finishing:

Cut yarn with 8" length remaining. Thread this onto a tapestry needle and through remaining stitches and then through center of hat to inside. Pull snugly to close up the remaining stitches and knot, then weave in all ends.
